

# LINK Locator App

The LINK App is the easy way of accessing cash on the move.



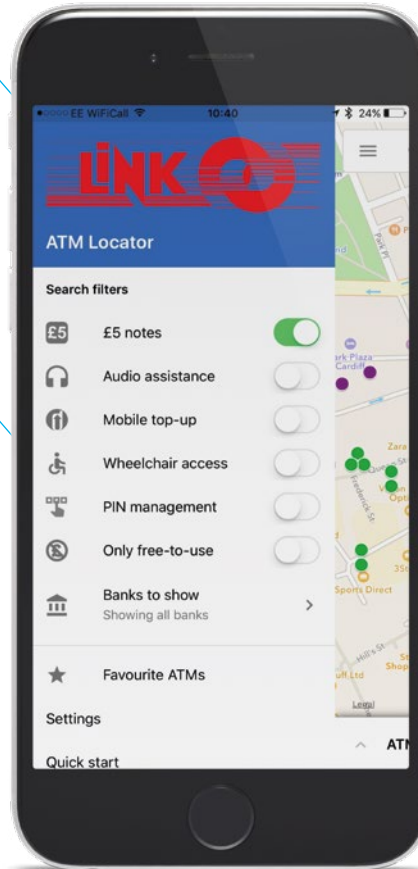
## Find your nearest ATM

The App shows on a map the ATMs that are closest to where you currently are, so you can find the most convenient way to access cash on the move. The App also allows you to search for ATMs in other locations to help you plan ahead.

## Filter your search results

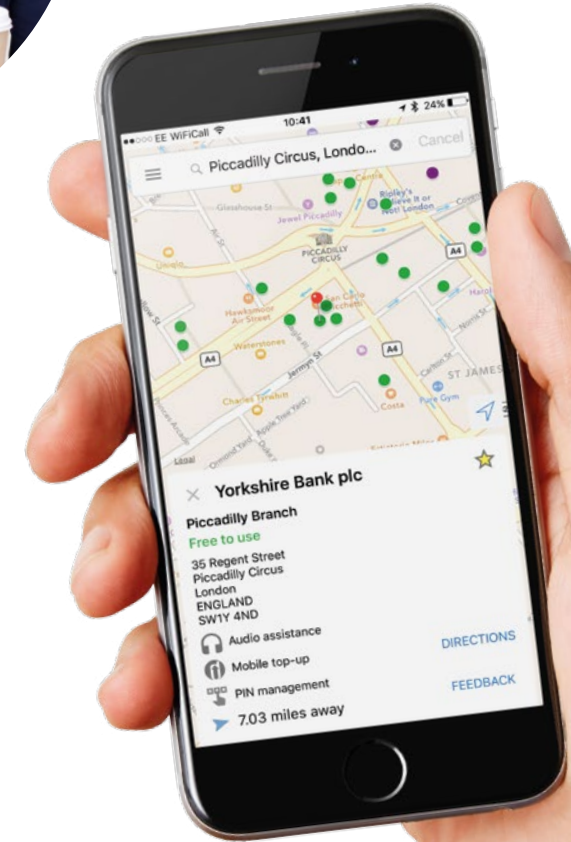
We recognise that some consumers are looking for specific types of ATMs to meet their needs, so the App provides an advanced search functionality. This enables you to filter your search results based on a number of criteria, such as:

- £5 note dispense
- audio assistance for consumers who are blind or partially sighted
- ATMs providing mobile phone top-up or PIN management functionality
- ATMs that are wheelchair accessible
- free-to-use ATMs or those belonging to specific organisations, e.g. your bank.



## Other functionalities

- Get directions to the ATM of your choice – either walking, driving or by public transport depending on your needs.
- Save your favourite ATMs. If you have certain ATMs that you like to use, because of their location or the facilities they provide, you can save them into your favorites and the App will alert you when you pass by to remind you to get your cash.
- Get advice and guidance for using ATMs, including hints and tips on personal safety and protecting your PIN.



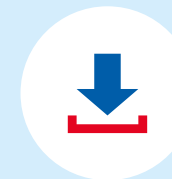
## Feedback

## Accessibility

The LINK Locator App is fully accessible with VoiceOver and TalkBack screen readers enabling consumers who are blind or partially sighted to access the full functionality of the App. In addition to this, you can filter your search so that it provides you with information on those ATMs that provide the audio assistance functionality.
